





### Computer Coding Program

This leadership coding workshop pilot was a free workshop to offer our youth in low impoverished areas the opportunity to understand computer coding by teaching them to CODE computer programs, gain passion for creating their own ideas, how to solve problems and create a service, and to feel comfortable choosing technology as a career. The Introduction to Programming curriculum incorporates the use of SCRATCH programming language, classroom instruction and laptops for use during the session.

At the end of the pilot, each student created a virtual card for their parents; used the techniques they learned to create a game called 'Monkey Mania' and at the end of the session each student competed in playing the game they just created.



#### St. Francis of Assisi Branch #49

St. Francis of Assisi Branch #49 in Breaux Bridge, LA recently completed it's Come Home for Christmas Retreat which was funded by the Saint Peter Claver Foundation - MICROGRANT. The focus of the grant was to bring back teens to church during the Christmas Season. It was highlighted by a detailed discussion on the meaning of Advent and Christmas Liturgical Seasons by Fr. Joseph Campion, Pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church. A session on the historical figures of the Bible was also a part of this retreat. Connections were made between how God used ordinary people to do great things and how God is calling each and everyone of us to do great things. All participants received the healing of reconciliation and attended Mass. The fiftythree attendees were invited to the Christmas Vigil Mass to Come Home for Christmas and witness the Nativity performed by the invitees. The Junior Knights and Daughters of Unit #49 also grew in their spirituality by sharing their faith and belief in God. ## Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology

Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology's goal for the Mission Possible Program was to connect and educate students on the option of going to college. Support from your organization provided 50 adults and displaced workers/students a way to learn about career and educational opportunities at OSUIT. Over ten students were accepted to our university and will be awarded scholarships. Once again thank you for your support with this event. This event truly helped our adults and displaced workers/students realize that college is an option, and opened them to the many possibilities education can afford them, and how they can afford a college education. ### St. Paul the Apostle Junior Daughters Court 351

On December 9, 2017, the Junior Daughters delivered care packages for 130 residents of Sterling Place Nursing Home in Baton Rouge, LA. In addition to the care packages, we delivered undershirts and throw blankets to be used as gifts for the residents at their Christmas Party. We were awarded \$500.00 from the foundation and the court held a fund-raiser to cover the additional cost. Items purchased total \$823.05. Receipts are on file if needed. Thanks to the generosity of the St. Peter Claver Foundation, we were able to touch the hearts of many of our seniors and put smiles on their faces while providing many of the personal care items they were in need of.
